

1 The Chairman of the Committee on the Calendar will be  
2 the man most conversant with that schedule, and it is  
3 possible, I suppose, that a proposal could suddenly come  
4 out that hadn't been anticipated, and no time to plan a  
5 debate limitation or a time limitation, but that could be  
6 dealt with in the Committee of the Whole. They would  
7 have the power to deal with it.

8 THE PRESIDENT: Are there any further questions  
9 of the Chairman of the Committee? Delegate Rybczynski?

10 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: Mr. President, I would  
11 like to ask a question concerning the amendment to Rule  
12 No. 28. It occurs to me that because of the importance  
13 of these reports, that this rule is a very good one.  
14 However, it occurs to me that minority reports will like-  
15 wise be very important for the future.

16 In the event that a delegate finds himself in  
17 a minority at the last minute on November 17, for instance,  
18 will there be an opportunity at a later date under these  
19 rules to submit a minority report for the consideration  
20 of the Convention?
