14 by saying Aye; contrary, No.

15 The Noes seem to have it. The Chair will call
16 for a roll call vote. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of
17 the amendment. A vote No is a vote against.

18 Have all delegates voted? Does any delegate
19 desire to change his vote? The Clerk will record the vote.
