My original statement from the top of my head, in answer to, I think Delegate Sickles' inquiry, was that it should probably apply only to Statewide offices, but then on correction from Delegate Lord and some notes that were passed to me hastily, by members of the Committee, and I think it was on Page 598 of the Draft Report, this does state very emphatically that it applies to anyone who is elected by the people; and this would include Statewide and local offices.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? The question arises on the adoption of Committee Recommendation No. GP-2, or approval of Committee Recommendation No. GP-2 as amended. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the approval of the recommendation as amended; a vote No is a vote against. All in favor, signify by saying Aye. Contrary, No. The Ayes seem to have it. The Ayes have it. The recommendation is approved.

That is the only business before the Committee of the Whole. The Chair recognizes Delegate Powers.
