three succeeding minority reports which concern a number of members of the legislature.

I would hate to see our effort down here split as under on a question of representation in the legislature. I think it is much more important that we get the Constitution passed on May 14 than that we get it completed on December 12.

THE PRESIDENT: The Chair would like to comment with respect to the statement just made, that the present difficulty in having the minority reports is not difficulty in the print shop, because the minority reports were not available until this afternoon, a very short time ago.

In addition, the minority reports will be available for all delegates this evening. Delegate Borom?

DELEGATE BOROM: Mr. Chairman, I think we want to be careful in considering the question or the issue on the Floor. I would hate for the delegates to vote in favor of Delegate Vecerá's motion and vote based on the arguments presented in reference to minority reports. I think we ought to divide the question and decide as a body whether we want the Baltimore City delegates to be off
