degree of haste and urgency that the situation requires in preparing these reports. We do have a very practical problem and that is that the Committee Staff has to first of all take care of the majority report, but we only were able to sign off on our minority report as of 2 o'clock this afternoon. Let me say that after the vote is had on the pending motion, I will move under Rule 20(a) to postpone consideration of the recommendations of the Legislative Branch Committee until the day after tomorrow.

THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Gleason, if the present motion carries, you would not have an opportunity to make such a motion, because we would have adjourned. It could be made tomorrow morning, of course, if the motion to amend fails, and we do convene tomorrow morning.

Before you make any other motion, may I call on Delegate Powers as Chairman of the Committee on Calendar to advise the delegates of the situation of the Calendar and the effect on the Calendar of either a deferral of consideration of Committee Recommendation LB-1 until another day, or adjournment of the Convention to another day?
