as to whether the schedule assumes a December 12 adjournment or whether schedule contemplates the possibility of our using the additional month provided in the enactment?

THE PRESIDENT: The Chairman of that Committee has heretofore stated that his schedule was based on compliance with the enactment, to be finished by December 12, and I think he has already answered your question.

Any further discussion? The question arises on the secondary amendment to Delegate Powers' motion to adjourn, that is, that the motion be amended to provide that the Convention adjourn until 12 noon tomorrow, Tuesday.

Are you ready for the question? A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment. A vote No is a vote against. All in favor, signify by saying Aye; contrary, No. The Chair is in doubt. A roll call vote. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment to adjourn until 12 noon tomorrow. A vote No is a vote against the amendment, and leaves Delegate Vecera's amendment before us. Please signify your votes.

Have all delegates voted? Does any delegate desire to change his vote? The Clerk will record the vote.
