DELEGATE POWERS: If you want to participate in the controlled debate on the side of the committee recommendation, see the chairman of the committee. If you want to participate on the other side, the chairman of the committee can certainly tell you who controls the minority and sometimes that will be divided among various people, depending upon the division of the issues, and if you don't get an agreement to get any time there, then the next thing to do is to get recognized as soon as you can.

DELEGATE WHEATLEY: One further question, and

I think it will be cleared in my mind. In the event you

were not able to be in the controlled debate and were

questioning as to whether or not there was such time allowed

for the uncontrolled debate, the only way to change that

would be to vote against the rule; is that correct?

DELEGATE POWERS: That is correct. If any delegate is not satisfied with the porposal tomorrow, for example, starting out on the committee recommendation of the Legislative Branch, there would be in addition to the usual Calendar and Agenda, there would be a debate scheduled, and at the time the motion is made to resolve the Convention
