into the Committee of the Whole, it would carry with it the adoption of the debate schedule. Any member who is aggrieved by the debate schedule would then be given an opporto assert his position, and there would be a vote of the majority of the Convention as to whether it was debatable.

DELEGATE WHEATLEY: In order to intelligently appraise this, would it be possible to have the tentative schedules advanced perhaps a day in advance? Otherwise, we may have to make on-the-spot decisions without being able to reflect upon them.

DELEGATE POWERS: In answer to the delegate's question, I will say at the beginning of this, it is probably a little more difficult at the beginning of this, and we are still working on the debate schedule for tomorrow now. As we have had more experience, and become more familiar with the procedure, and also determine the will of the majority of the Convention with respect to the procedure, I believe that it will be entirely possible to have the debate scheduled out several days in advance.
