just adopted. The primary motion as amended is that the Convention adjourn until 12 noon tomorrow. Delegate Vecera's amendment to that, which would be a substitute for it, is that we adjourn until 10 a.m. Wednesday. If that motion fails, then the question before you arises on the motion to adjourn until 12 noon tomorrow. Delegate Marion?

DELEGATE MARION: Mr. President, a point of parliamentary inquiry: My impression was that the motion we voted on a few moments ago was a motion to amend Delegate Vecera's proposed amendment so that the issue now before us would be Delegate Vecera's proposed amendment as amended by Delegate Bard's amendment. If that is not the case, there may be other delegates as confused as I am.

THE PRESIDENT: That is not the case. The statement that the Chair just made is, I think, the correct statement, as I have been advised by the Parliamentarian; but I think the question is clearly before you: On the pending question, you will decide whether you want to adjourn until Wednesday or not. If that is carried, obviously, you will vote for the motion to adjourn
