

1 delegate, please when you pick up the microphone, grasp it
2 firmly by the lower portion near the swivel joint. Do not
3 grasp it up towards the front. This results in some sort
4 of electronic disturbance and distortion. Hold it this
5 way, and hold it firmly. Do not hold it away from your
6 face. With the new microphones that have been put in, the
7 volume must be kept down to eliminate distortion. They
8 should be kept within a matter of an inch or two from your
9 mouth. In this way also if you turn your head, your micro-
10 phone will follow.

11 A few simple rules, hold the microphone firmly
12 by the lower portion, not up close to the end. Speak in
13 a normal tone of voice, but hold the microphone within an
14 inch or two from your mouth.
