seat on the Floor. We will follow the practice for convenience of having him occupy the President's chair on the Floor, but he will be speaking from the Floor.

We will then, under this debate schedule, take up the Committee Recommendation LB-1 for section-by-section consideration, seriatim, for purpose of amendment. tion 3.01 would then be open to amendment. Under the rules that we are following, minority spokesmen are entitled to priority in submitting an amendment. In this particular situation, there are, as to some sections, more than one minority report. As to Section 3.01, there is only one minority report. Accordingly, when we move into the section-by-section consideration, and Section 3.01 is called for amendment, I would recognize Delegate Hanson, who is the spokesman for the minority. At that point, he would present the minority report from the Clerk's desk. This, again, would be a presentation of the minority position, with questions and answers, and not debate.

At the conclusion of that period, Delegate

Hanson would resume his seat and would be recognized for
the purpose of submitting an amendment. At that point,
