1	ments dealing with the same subject, following a consider-
2	ation of the three minority reports. This procedure could
3	result in the Convention, in the Committee of the Whole
4	wasting time, debate, alternate procedures, when a majority
5	of the Committee clearly wants it earlier, but I think as
6	a procedure to follow until we see just what kind of amend-
7	ments develop, it will be preferable to following the strict
8	procedure that would have us involved in secondary amend-
9	ments to amendments, et cetera. Accordingly, I simply
10	want to announce to you that in connection with the
11	debate schedule now before you, keep in mind the two things I
12	have mentioned: The debate schedule other than the five-
13	minute limitations debate only on the matters mentioned
14	therein, and in the case of successive amendments to the same
15	section, we will treat them successively and not be con-
16	cerned with whether they are primary or secondary amend-
17	ments.
