

1 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: M r. Chairman, in the
2 uncontrolled time which follows the discussion by
3 the minority reports spokesmen or the Chairmen on the
4 various sections, may a Delegate speak to either a majority
5 report or the minority report without offering an amendment
6 to either of those reports?

7 DELEGATE POWERS: The answer to that is yes, he
8 may, subject to a limitation of three minutes. He may
9 speak favorably or unfavorably on the matter immediately
10 before the Convention.

11 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: And what are those steps
12 which you say can be taken to extend the uncontrolled time
13 if it is necessary?

14 DELEGATE POWERS: If we reach the point where
15 the uncontrolled time appears to be insufficient to give
16 the Delegates a reasonable opportunity to present their
17 point, we would move that the Committee of the Whole
18 rise and report to the Convention that we desire to
19 amend the debate schedule to permit further time.

20 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: I would address an inquiry
21 to the Chair: Is there no way to accomplish that purpose
