4 procedure to do that is not a matter of delay. It is a  
5 30 second matter.

7 Delegate Chabot.

8 DELEGATE CHABOT: My understanding would be  
9 that a motion to reconsider an action taken in the  
10 Committee of the Whole may be made at any time before the  
11 Committee of the Whole arises. It arising merely to ac-  
12 complish the purpose outlined by Delegate Bamberger serves  
13 to cut off the opportunity to make such motion to recon-  
14 sider.

15 THE PRESIDENT: If the Chair were presented that  
16 situation it would rule that the rising of the Committee  
17 merely to seek further instructions from the Convention  
18 would not affect the rule as to reconsideration.
