without the Committee of the Whole rising and reporting 1 to the Convention? 2 THE PRESIDENT: No, I don't think so; but the 3 procedure to do that is not a matter of delay. It is a 4 30 second matter. 5 Any further discussion? 6 Delegate Chabot. 7 DELEGATE CHABOT: My understanding would be 8 that a motion to reconsider an action taken in the 9 Committee of the Whole may be made at any time before the 10 Committee of the Whole arises. It arising merely to ac-11 complish the purpose outlined by Delegate Bamberger serves 12 to cut off the opportunity to make such motion to recon-13 sider. 14 THE PRESIDENT: If the Chair were presented that 15 situation it would rule that the rising of the Committee 16 merely to seek further instructions from the Convention 17 would not affect the rule as to reconsideration. 18 Delegate Clark. 19 Mr. Chairman, is it possible DELEGATE CLARK: 20 to reapportion the controlled time just by announcing it?

21
