

1 We have ten minutes allotted to two speakers here.

2 Could I just announce that this will be 15 and 5?

3 THE PRESIDENT: It is really not working that  
4 way, Delegate Clark. The person controlling the  
5 time has the complete control over the time.

6 For instance, in section 3.04, when I recognize  
7 you for debate under that section, you may speak as briefly  
8 or as long as you want within that time, and  
9 then when I recognize you again, if you did not use your  
10 ten minutes, you will simply yield whatever number of  
11 minutes you desire to whatever Delegate you desire.

12 DELEGATE CLARK: Thank you, sir.

13 THE PRESIDENT: Control merely means that the  
14 minority spokesman or majority spokesman is controlling  
15 the allocation of that limited time among the Delegates to  
16 speak. It doesnot mean he is speaking himself for that  
17 period of time.
