It is really not working that THE PRESIDENT: way, Delegate Clark. The person controlling the 4 time has the complete control over the time. 5 For instance, in section 3.04, when I recognize 6 you for debate under that section, you may speak as briefly 7 or as long as you want within that time, and 8 then when I recognize you again, if you did not use your 9 ten minutes, you will simply yield whatever number of 10 minutes you desire to whatever Delegate you desire. 11 Thank you, sir. DELEGATE CLARK: 12 THE PRESIDENT: Control merely means that the 13 minority spokesman or majority spokesman is controlling 14 the allocation of that limited time among the Delegates to 15 speak. It does not mean he is speaking himself for that 16 period of time. 17 Delegate Adkins. 18 DELEGATE ADKINS: Mr. Chairman, is a motion 19 to amend the debate schedule in order? 20 THE PRESIDENT: It is, sir. 21
