responsibility, this greater opportunity for public scrutiny, the committee felt 15 to 5, I might say, 15 to 5, the roll call vote on the subject matter, would provide a better Senate and a better House and a better kind of representation for the people of Maryland.

Of course, one of the happy by-products of using the single-member district would be the cutting down on the long ballot.

There is a significant effort being made in this convention to eliminate the long ballot by eliminating certain state-wide offices, and certainly if one is to follow the logic of this approach, the cutting down on 60 and 70 candidates would certainly provide an extelligent opportunity for greater voter intelligent participation at election time.
