

1 THE PRESIDENT: Is there a second?

2 (The motion was duly seconded.)

3 THE PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Delegate Chabot?

4 DELEGATE CHABOT: As I said, I do not believe that
5 we need these goals. I believe that Rule 30, which per-
6 mits the Convention to take any matter from any committee
7 at any time that the Convention feels it ought to come
8 before the Convention is sufficient. I feel that the
9 provision of a specific date in Rule 28(a) creates an
10 unnecessary and probably, as the date approaches, quite
11 inconvenient limitation on the consideration that the
12 committees ought to give to the many proposals that are
13 and will be put before them.

14 THE PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion?
15 Are you ready for the question? The question arises on
16 the adoption of a new Rule 28(a) as printed in the
17 Committee's report. An affirmative vote is a vote in
18 favor of the additional rule. All those in favor, signify
19 by saying Aye; contrary, No. The Ayes seem to have it.
