15 by saying that it is, of course, tied in with the bicameral
16 recommendation in the earlier section and also with
17 a relatively small-sized House and Senate. Any significant
18 increase in the size of the House and Senate would do
19 injury to the concept of the single member district, in
20 view of the fact that it would considerably lower the num-
21 ber of people represented and make the districts much more
