2                   I turn now to consideration of Section 3.05, the  
3       qualifications of legislators.

4                   I should like to read it: "To be eligible as a  
5       senator or delegate a person shall be a qualified voter of  
6       the State of Maryland at the time of selection or appoint-  
7       ment, shall have been a resident of the State for at least  
8       two years immediately preceding his election or appointment,  
9       and shall have been a resident of his senate district for  
10      at least six months immediately preceding his election or  
11      appointment. If, however, any redistricting plan for  
12      senate districts has been adopted within one year before  
13      a general election for the General Assembly, he shall be  
14      eligible in that general election to run either in the  
15      senate district in which he resides, or in any other  
16      senate district containing 50 per cent or more of the  
17      population of the senate district in which he resided prior  
18      to redistricting. To be eligible as a senator, a person  
19      shall have attained the age of twenty-five years and to be  
20      eligible as a delegate, he shall attain the age of twenty-  
21      one years at the time of his election or appointment."
