I turn now to consideration of Section 3.05, the qualifications of legislators.

I should like to read it: "To be eligible as a senator or delegate a person shall be a qualified voter of the State of Maryland at the time of selection or appointment, shall have been a resident of the State for at least two years immediately preceding his election or appointment, and shall have been a resident of his senate district for at least six months immediately preceding his election or appointment. If, however, any redistricting plan for senate districts has been adopted within one year before a general election for the General Assembly, he shall be eligible in that general election to run either in the senate district in which he resides, or in any other senate district containing 50 per cent or more of the population of the senate district in which he resided prior to redistricting. To be eligible as a senator, a person shall have attained the age of twenty-five years and to be eligible as a delegate, he shall attain the age of twentyone years at the time of his election or appointment."
