on whims or fancy or some light reason, but would only do so provided they felt that there was an opportunity to accomplish something positive and there was some genuine need which had to be acted upon immediately.

Because of the difficulty in gearing up and getting staffs together, which we realize, we believe that no special session of the General Assembly would be called except for a good reason.

It is interesting to note, I think, that 15 other States of the Union allow the General Assembly to convoke itself into special session.

Turning now to the last section of the Committee Report on compensation of legislators, reading the language, "The members of the General Assembly shall receive such salary and allowances as may be prescribed by law. creases in salary shall not apply to the General Assembly which enacted them. No Senator or Delegate shall be paid daily living expenses during regular session of the General Assembly."

The effect of this proposed new Constitutional section is to remove from the Maryland Constitution the
