

1 benefit of it, unless and until they stand for election
2 and are reelected, at which time they return as a new
3 General Assembly and shall be entitled to the increase;
4 so that you have the opportunity on the part of the public
5 for it to demonstrate by the way it selects or fails to
6 select those who return to the General Assembly what their
7 reactions may be with respect to the salary increase.

8 We have only provided that there be no living
9 expenses during the regular sessions of the General Assembly.
10 This does not prohibit off regular session payments for
11 committee work, per diem expenses for meetings of the
12 special sessions of the General Assembly. All this does
13 is to guarantee, if adopted, that while the General Assembly
14 itself is in regular session, there shall not be per diem
15 payments.

16 This probably will act to some degree as a
17 restraining influence upon those who might be tempted to
18 vote for a continuation of the 90 day session for another
19 30 or a second 30 days, simply on the enticement of the
20 additional \$25.00 per day. Consequently, the meeting of
21 the regular session will not be accompanied by this
