employee. He may under the present system be entitled to, and is entitled to, some pension benefits at the end of eight years.

Now, the Committee recognized, having heard testimony, that the pension system was indeed quite generous. It recognized that the increase of the salary to \$8,000 would have a corresponding increase in the impact of the beneficial aspects of the pensions upon the members of the General Assembly. Consequently the Committee authorized the writing to the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate to request that it review the pension arrangements of the General Assembly, and I am told that the Legislative Committee has met and has decided to recommend a review of the present pension arrangements.

We did not feel it was our duty, and certainly it was beyond the scope of our knowledge, to get into attempts to change the pension system, because this would have involved an exploration into acturaial areas which would have consumed far more time than our Committee could have possibly allotted to it.

We believe that the question should be, how
