

1 as not prohibiting the payment for travel.

2 DELEGATE M. SMITH: You and I are not in the same  
3 boat. I am concerned about the distance that a delegate  
4 may be located from the ends of his district. Did you  
5 give consideration to that, sir?

6 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: The Committee recognized  
7 that the geographical confines of the districts were very  
8 great, but we did not attempt to act upon it in any way.  
9 The General Assembly would not be prohibited from  
10 compensating those legislators who have these large areas  
11 to travel by some special arrangement or allotment  
12 or general appropriation.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Smith.

14 DELEGATE M. SMITH: With my question I am not  
15 so much concerned, sir, with reference to the compensation  
16 to the legislator as I am my ability as a constituent  
17 to contact my legislator.

18 Now, did you give any consideration to that,  
19 sir?

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Smith, I think  
21 your question wasn't too clear. If you would pinpoint it
