6 I recognize Delegate Scanlan to report on the  
7 second item referred to the Committee, Resolution No. 2.

8 **DELEGATE SCANLAN:** Mr. President, fellow dele-  
9 gates, the Committee, especially myself, apologize for the  
10 failure to have a written report regarding Committee  
11 action on Resolution No. 2. You will recall it came up  
12 rather late in the day yesterday, and we had a quick meet-  
13 ing of the Committee, and to make a long story short, the  
14 Committee had recommended an unfavorable report on this  
15 resolution. Briefly, the Committee was of the unanimous  
16 view that the matter dealt with in the resolution is not  
17 a fit subject for a rule. The question of when the Con-  
18 vention convenes or adjourns is something the Convention  
19 itself is master of, through its President, its officers,  
20 its Calendar Committee, and this is a flexible thing.  
21 There will be times when we will be very busy. There will
