

1 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I think my response to that
2 is that the Constitution does not set forth in detail the
3 suffrage and election laws, but would expect the General
4 Assembly to implement them.

5 DELEGATE HICKMAN: According to the Constitution
6 as it is now presented to us, one person could represent
7 three delegate districts in the House of Delegates?

8 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I would say that it is
9 theoretically possible, but I would further suggest that
10 if this Constitution is adopted that the General Assembly
11 would set up an orderly system of determining options.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions, Delegate
13 Hickman?

14 DELEGATE HICKMAN: Delegate Gallagher, I see
15 nothing which states that this may be done by law.

16 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: There is another section
17 which I believe is forthcoming with respect to holding
18 one office of profit and trust. One of the difficulties
19 I think in taking the sections piecemeal is that we do not
20 have before us some complementary legislation, constitutional
21 provisions which would take care of these things.
