

1 DELEGATE MASON: Mr. Chairman, on page 8
2 of your Memorandum, it reads as follows:

3 The Committee has tentatively agreed that the
4 35-105 membership limitation and the single-member district
5 shall not be applied to the present General Assembly. The
6 Committee intends for these changes to be applied to the
7 first legislature elected following the 1970 reapportionment.

8 My question is, when will this become operative?

9 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: If there is no change in the
10 schedule of state-wide elections, the next election for
11 the General Assembly will occur in 1970.

12 At that time, however, on the basis of information
13 which we have, there will not be in our hands sufficient
14 data from the Federal Census Bureau to apportion or reappor-
15 tion the General Assembly, based on the 1970 figures, so
16 therefore, presuming no change in the elections scheduled,
17 the first General Assembly that this limitation can apply
18 to will be that General Assembly which was elected in 1974.
