of 30 days. We did not provide the limitation on the length of the special session.

THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Chabot?

DELEGATE CHABOT: I would like to advert to the language referred to by Delegate Scanlan. The Court of Appeals has held that under the present language, the General Assembly is not permitted to refer on its own motion general public laws to referendum; that this would be an improper delegation of the legislative power.

Is it your understanding that this language would continue that interpretation?

DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I have not had as yet an opportunity to study the referendum language from the Committee on Suffrage and Elections but I do not believe this intends to make a change in that.

THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Chabot?

DELEGATE CHABOT: As to Section 3.05, the language is used, to be eligible as a senator or delegate, a person shall be a qualified voter.
