8 or with regard to your belief, and it seems to be a firm
9 belief in your report, that the committee system in the
10 House of Delegates would be changed, et cetera, that if this
11 is upset, then is it possible that your committee might
12 change its recommendation with regard to unicameral and
13 bicameralism.

14 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: It might possibly. I
15 don't know that the rules would allow us to do anything
16 significant about that, but we could meet and condemn the
17 document in absentia or something like that.
