8 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: My purpose is to clarify  
9 the Chairman's answer. I think he missed the last word  
10 of Delegate Byrnes' question, which was whether they  
11 could authorize additional payments as salary, and the other  
12 prohibition on salary prohibits an increase in salary being  
13 applicable to that General Assembly.

14 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I think Delegate Byrnes was  
15 addresssing himself to a per diem expense beyond the 90th  
16 day.

17 DELEGATE BYRNES: Delegate Bamberger clarified  
18 properly my question. I am referring to the salary.  
19 I was referring directly to your point, that you barred  
20 the per diem becuase of the enticement effect, and you  
21 clarified by saying it was not the exclusive reason, but
