

1 We believe rather that legislation should be
2 under constant review from its initiation and introduction
3 until its final passage.

4 We think, Mr. Chairman, that the second house
5 is not now, has never been and is not likely to be an ade-
6 quate safeguard against sloppy legislation. The only ade-
7 quate safeguard is to provide a strong and a responsible
8 legislature, and so structured that we can expect, within
9 reason, that the behavior of each member will be the most
10 responsible.
