

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gleason?

2 DELEGATE GLEASON: One hundred would be 40 less
3 than the 35-105 ratio and I am wondering, how do you provide
4 for minority representation, representation of minority
5 groups in the state with that kind of a figure?

6 DELEGATE HANSON: I think it would be well to
7 point out that minority representation in the state is provided
8 not by the 35 figure, but by the 105 figure, using single-
9 member districts.

10 I think single-member districts are an important
11 and integral part of minority representation, so my answer
12 to you is that minorities would be represented in the same
13 manner in a unicameral body as they would be in a bicameral
14 body.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions of the
16 Minority spokesman?

17 Delegate Neilson?

18 DELEGATE NEILSON: Mr. Hanson, from a practical
19 standpoint as a spokesman for the Minority party, what
20 do you think --

21 DELEGATE HANSON: Minority, not Minority party.
