

1 DELEGATE BENNETT: I wish to ask him a question
2 if he will permit me, one that I neglected during this
3 period of so-called clarification we had.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher, will you
5 yield for a question?

6 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I am afraid I will.
7 (Laughter.)

8 DELEGATE BENNETT: In your very effective
9 service here in the legislature, Mr. Gallagher, you have at
10 times, I take it, served on conference committees when
11 there have been disagreeing votes of the two branches of
12 the legislature. In that conference committee, you have
13 come out, I take it, as does the Congress of the United
14 States, with a bill which is completely different from
15 that either passed by the House of Delegates or the
16 Senate and enjoys a low visibility that that sort of pro-
17 cedure presented.

18 What I want to know is whether or not such a
19 procedure not only is of low visibility as I say, but does
20 it not thwart the will of both houses and therefore some-
21 thing not to be applauded?
