

1 under the controlled time. But if the Chair could take
2 some kind of sense of the Committee, I think I could
3 reserve the time remaining for rebuttal at the end and
4 perhaps if the people who have agreed to speak have no ob-
5 jection, they might speak under the uncontrolled time seg-
6 ment.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair would be disposed in
8 view of the hour to continue the debate with the uncon-
9 trolled time, but I don't believe that we could permit
10 you then to come back and have sole rebuttal, Delegate
11 Hanson.

12 DELEGATE HANSON: I was not suggesting I might
13 have sole rebuttal but that the Chairman of the Committee
14 on the Legislative Branch and myself might reserve an
15 equal amount of time for rebuttal.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair will proceed with un-
17 controlled time and allow each of you at the end of the
18 debate as to which time is uncontrolled whatever time the
19 shorter time that the two of you have, I am not sure
20 which that is.
