

1 I don't know whether that experience is shared by other
2 members, is the fact that people are generally confused,
3 especially the new people that have moved into the State,
4 and this is not a unicameral number, are generally confused
5 as to what a member of the House of Delegates, which branch
6 of the Government/^{he} really belongs to.

7 I know, of course, that the House of Delegates
8 has a long meaning to the natural born and native born
9 residents of this State, but when we take a look at the word
10 "delegate", a delegate goes to a convocation or a conven-
11 tion or some other assembly with a specific mission. He
12 is not going there as a representative. He is going there
13 under restrictions, with a specific job to take care of.
14 He is not a representative. To this extent the remaining
15 delegates in the House of Delegates is a misnomer and mis-
16 leading.

17 When we take a look at what the lower house
18 of the legislature is termed in the other fifty States
19 of the Union, excluding, of course Nebraska, which has
20 the unicameral legislation, we find the forty-nine States
21 designating their lower house as the House of Represen-
