

1 You need your senators' offices, offices for the house
2 members, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the
3 House, you need such things as the minority rooms, majority
4 rooms for caucuses, press rooms, TV room, telephone switch-
5 board, legislative reference, legislative staff, State
6 police, canteen or luncheon room, committee or hearing
7 rooms; you need parking facilities, Post Office, an
8 office for the Chief Clerk, the Secretary of the Senate,
9 a legislative accounting office, an attorney general,
10 duplicating rooms.

11 Speaking of duplicating, now we do our printing
12 in Baltimore. With proper facilities it would enormously
13 improve the situation if we were able to do our printing
14 right here in Annapolis.

15 You need lounges and places for receptionists,
16 and this is probably an incomplete list. It will require
17 a great deal of attention and study, but certainly, and
18 I am making this basic point, providing these facilities
19 in an orderly and logical basis for an 80 man house and
20 40 member senate is certainly much more easily accomplished
21 if your house and senate are of reasonable size.
