

1 I do know that they have provided Constitutional
2 requirements concerning ethics, which really bars a legis-
3 lator from participating in private activities.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

5 DELEGATE CASE: Mr. Chairman, have you made
6 any studies to determine the efficiency of a House of
7 Delegates composed of 105 members vis-a-vis one composed
8 of 80 members?

9 DELEGATE JAMES: No. I have had a little per-
10 sonal experience. I think the 105 member house is an
11 improvement. I think the 80 member house is better. I
12 think this, that the sooner we are able to organize
13 the committee structure of the senate and the house along
14 similar lines for the purpose of facilitating joint
15 committee efforts, I think the better off we will be.
16 I think the 80 member house would achieve this result.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

18 DELEGATE CASE: The recommendation which you
19 make, Senator James, represents a two-to-one relationship
20 between the senate and the house, whereas the majority
21 recommendation is a three-to-one relationship.
