4 your amendment did not contain anything about how the
5 delegates should be selected. Do you wish to retain the
6 present system?

7 DELEGATE JAMES: There will be single member
8 districts in the house. Each senatorial district basically
9 would be a composite district of one senator and two dele-
10 gates.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Marion.

12 DELEGATE MARION: Mr. James, isn't it correct
13 that in addition to the States of California and New Jersey
14 which you have mentioned that there are perhaps 16 or 18
15 other States which either use directly the two-to-one
16 ratio or very close to the two-to-one ratio between their
17 house and senate?

18 DELEGATE JAMES: I am not sure of the statis-
19 tics. I imagine there are others. I picked out two out-
20 standing examples.
