3 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair would be disposed to rule
4 that this would still be two separate distinct questions.

5 Do the sponsors agree?

6 DELEGATE JAMES: Yes.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Amendment No. 3, then, will be
8 divided. The question now before you will be on the first
9 sentence of the substitute in Amendment No. 3, the sentence
10 from lines 8 through the middle of line 12.

11 Delegate Bamberger?

12 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: Mr. President, a point of
13 parliamentary inquiry. If we divide this, will that then
14 require us to vote on those words which are in line 12 to
15 16 immediately after we vote on the words in lines 8 to 12?

16 THE CHAIRMAN: That is correct.

17 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: In other words, will we first
18 take up the point of the number and then be required at
19 this point to vote on whether there shall be single-member
20 districts in the House or the Senate, regardless of the
21 size?
