3 today, but in so doing, I simply state that 35-105, which
4 is the committee recommendation, it would appear to allow
5 full committee operation on the House level and the Senate
6 level as well.

9 DELEGATE SHERBOW: Mr. Chairman, I speak in
10 opposition to the amendment.

11 Nobody knows what is the ideal size of a family
12 and we will never know what is the ideal, per fect size
13 of the General Assembly. I think our eyes ought to be
14 focused, not on what experience shows took place years ago,
15 but what is happening now with the new picture created by
16 the one-man, one-vote principle.

17 There has been a tremendous change in the
18 General Assembly, not only in what it has done, but in public
19 approval of what it has done and is doing.

20 Leadership, a new breed of leadership is
21 springing out of this kind of a change. If we get this
