

1 not call for 40-80. Theoretically, you could have  
2 a general assembly composed of two senators or two repre-  
3 sentatives and one senator.

4 In other words, the size of the House and of  
5 the Senate is left to the General Assembly and does not  
6 mean 40 and it does not mean 80.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Any other delegate desire to speak  
8 in favor of the amendment?

9 Delegate Henderson?

10 DELEGATE HENDERSON: I shall be very brief. I  
11 simply want to agree with Judge Sherbow's statement that  
12 the desirability, the most desirable thing is to have  
13 contact between the legislature and the constituents and  
14 the voters of the state.

15 One thing I have observed over the years is that  
16 matters are not debated in the General Assembly on the  
17 floor. Matters are handled in committee, and the only people  
18 really who speak on the floor after the noses have been  
19 counted are those who are showing off or have no hope of  
20 winning in a debate.
