

1 a vote against the Committee amendment -- I am sorry;  
2 against the amendment, and in favor of the Committee recom-  
3 mendation.

4 Cast your votes. Has every delegate voted?  
5 Does any delegate desire to change his vote?

6 The Clerk will record the vote. There being  
7 45 votes in the affirmative and 83 in the negative, the  
8 motion is lost. That portion of the amendment fails.

9 Do I understand from the sponsors that in view  
10 of the action just taken that they do not desire to  
11 submit the remainder?

12 DELEGATE JAMES: We withdraw it.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: The sponsors desire to withdraw  
14 the remainder of Amendment No. 3, and number 3 therefore  
15 fails.

16 DELEGATE GLEASON: Mr. Chairman.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Just a second, Delegate Gleason.

18 For what purpose does Delegate Gleason rise?

19 DELEGATE GLEASON: Mr. Chairman, I would like  
20 to inquire as to what the desires of the Chair are with  
21 respect to time. It would suit the purposes of the minority
