more of these we could get as quickly as possible, it would help us organize our work. In view of the change of hours announced for the meeting of the Convention on Monday, there will be a meeting of the Preamble and Personal Rights Committee at 2 p.m. on Monday.

DELEGATE SHERBOW: Mr. President, until the machinery for liaison with other committees is completed and established, I would make this announcement for the State Taxation and Finance Committee. On Tuesday there will be a hearing dealing with the subject of state bond issues with the governor's director of his task force, Mr. Lauber, the State Comptroller, and the State Commissioner present as witnesses and on Wednesday representatives of financial institutions will be heard.

Those members of other committees whose work will also relate to this aspect of state government I hope will take note of these hearings and if interested, arrange to be present.
