3 DELEGATE GLEASON: Certainly it would be sub-
4 ject to a veto. I think we will have to wait on the
5 referendum until we get a report from the Committee handling
6 that. I don't know. It would certainly be subject to a
7 government gubernatorial veto, and it should be.
