be taken up on Monday will be constitutional recognition of education, which, of course, would include guarantees, direction of education, the intent that this Convention proposes to include in the Constitution concerning the intent of education and we would extend a hearty invitation to any of the delegates present who may want to be heard on this particular issue. Later on the General Provision Committee will consider many other facets of education. For the time being, we will limit our invitation to those who may wish to be heard on the constitutional recognition of education, 2 p.m. on Monday. Thank you, sir.

THE PRESIDENT: Any further announcements by committee chairman?

If not, I have just a few other things to mention before the adjournment. The announcement by committee chairmen indicates that there is a rather heavy schedule of committee meetings and hearings for next week.
