

1 small counties. There were articulate spokesmen for the  
2 small counties on our committee.

3 This Convention, this committee has before it  
4 the testimony of its two vice presidents, one of whom is a  
5 President of the Senate, the other of whom is a distinguished  
6 member of the Senate both of whom say to you, the present  
7 size is not the most efficient, the present size is not  
8 efficient.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: You have little less than a half  
10 minute.

11 DELEGATE BAMBURGER: I suggest with that  
12 testimony we ought to be convinced, that we ought to  
13 reduce the size. Now 35-105 is the product of compromise.  
14 I point out to you that of the seven present or former  
15 members of the General Assembly who served on the  
16 committee, four, as noted in the committee report, voted  
17 for the 35-105, four voted that it shall be 35-105,  
18 and that we shall free the General Assembly from this  
19 problem, this trauma, so it may attend to its work.
