

1 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Mr. Chairman, I will not allo-
2 cate. I will simply say this: Delegate Roselli Abrams
3 here asked for a size of 100 and 33, Charles Doctor,
4 80 to 100 in the House, 40 in the Senate, Delegate Finney,
5 or Senator Finney, 33 Senators and a smaller House;
6 Delegate Blair Lee, 80 House members, 40 Senators; Mr.
7 Mandell, 100 House members, 40 Senators; Delegate Sarbans,
8 105-35, Delegate Edna Cook, 123-member House, a smaller
9 Senate, Delegate James, 80-40, Delegate Clark, 80-40.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: There is now authorized 20
11 minutes of uncontrolled debate. Does any delegate desire
12 to speak in favor of the amendment?

13 Delegate Gleason?

14 DELEGATE GLEASON: Mr. Chairman, I wonder at
15 this time if we could get a motion to extend the time for
16 the unallotted time so to speak from three to five minutes.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: The allotted time per speaker
18 is presently five minutes under the schedule, as amended.
19 I suggest, however, that since total time is 20 minutes,
20 that obviously it would be unfair to have many delegates
