

1 DELEGATE SOLLINS: Or 30-90 -- any number of
2 possible combinations.

3 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: That is correct.

4 DELEGATE SOLLINS: With the multiple member
5 situation that you have suggested here, would that be
6 applicable throughout the State, or could there be some
7 areas that would be single member districts and
8 some multiple?

9 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: Some could be single member
10 districts, others multiple member districts.

11 DELEGATE SOLLINS: That would be within the
12 latitude of the legislature.

13 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: There are 55 legislative
14 bodies in the United States, including both senates and
15 houses, out of 99, that are currently using this system.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions?
